Joseph Sciacca Memorial Scholarship Program

Syosset Baseball Association is offering a scholarship to a Syosset High School senior who wishes to continue their education upon graduation. The scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1,500.00.

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must be a Syosset High School senior currently on the Syosset Varsity Baseball roster and exhibit the following qualities:

A. Participation - Applicants must have played in 50% of their teams games in at least three seasons of the Syosset Baseball Association's junior or Senior Division. An exception to this requirement may be made if an injury precludes playing in one of the seasons

B. Academic Achievement - Applicants must be accepted by an accredited institution of higher learning.C.

Social Responsibility - the committee will consider participation in extra-curricular or community activity.

Applications are due to the Syosset Baseball Association by May 5th. Official Announcement of the scholarship winners will be made at the Syosset High School Senior Awards Night. Applications may be mailed to Syosset Baseball Association's, P.O. Box 302, Syosset, NY 11791, or delivered in person to a member of the Board of Directors.

After applications are received, finalists will be selected. Finalists will be requested to attend a personal interview with the Selection Committee. Scholarship proceeds will be forwarded to the school of the winner's choice. Scholarship is to cover cost of tuition and books or \$1,500.00, whichever is less. If the cost of tuition and books is less than \$1,500.00 per school period, the balance left will remain in the scholarship account for use in the future for that winner's continuing education. Winners may elect to receive the scholarship proceeds over a two-year or four-year period: however, the total amount of the scholarship is not to exceed \$1,500.00. In case of a tie, the Syosset Baseball Association reserves the right to determine the allocation of the award.
